





Incarcerated Parents Video Kit for Men (#5229)




This collection of videos is especially for incarcerated fathers who want to take personal responsibility and action for their choices, and want to remain close to their children.

The Story of Mothers and Daughters (#6933)


An intimate, deeply moving, and painfully honest award-winning documentary film about the profoundly important mother-daughter bond


Examines the problem of absent fathers, its causes, and its effects, from poverty to violence. It also looks at some efforts to reverse this growing trend.
