Post-Prison Blues

Deals with the emotional challenges of prison release. Inmates and experts relate their experiences and valuable insights on how to make the emotional transition. They talk about dealing with the label "ex-convict," coping with the change from structured time, surviving without support from family or friends, helping children understand why they were in prison, and dealing with the often uncertain future. 28 minutes. \$129.00.

This moving documentary explores the special bond between mothers and daughters by letting dozens of ordinary women share their insights, emotions, and experiences. This DVD focuses on an unusual parenting program at a federal penitentiary. Called "H.O.P.E. For Life," it assists prison inmates who candidly admit to being poor fathers. Role playing between these two groups brings to the surface the pain and anger each individual suffers. The men must reveal the anger of their own childhoods before they can sincerely apologize to their children. \$99.95

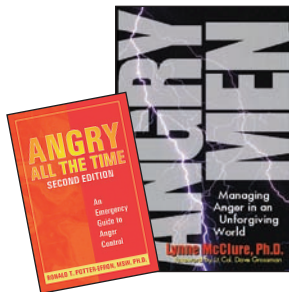
Anger and Rage
